

## **AKA 2009 Class Structure**

For the 2009 season there will be changes to the class structure. To increase the class size and eliminate classes with one or two karts several classes may be discontinued. We realize this is a big change but will increase the number of karts per race making for better racing.

If three or more karts show up to race that don't fall into the one of the classes listed below, they will be allowed to run in their own separate class for that day.

Listed below will be the classes running this year.

ALL DRIVERS MUST BE QUALIFIED TO RACE A GIVEN CLASS ACCORDING TO THE WKA RULE BOOK.

ADDITIONAL CLASSES, OTHER THAN THOSE LISTED, MAY BE ADDED ON ANY DAY DEPENDING ON INTEREST AND TURN OUT.
